# Application Procedure

Pacific Life Bible College

We welcome your application to Pacific Life Bible College. Reading through the following checklist will help you in choosing the correct forms and understanding the required fees for our various programs, and will speed up the admission process.

## 1. Application Packet (Campus or Distance Education)

PLBC will acknowledge your application upon receipt of the Application Packet which includes the following forms and fees for either campus or distance education students.

### Application for Admission

- Complete the application form.
- Enclose a non-refundable application fee of \$35 CDN (\$50 for Counselling students) for Canadian and U.S. students. The application fee for foreign students is \$50.
- Include a passport size photograph.

### Transcripts

- Arrange to have **official** transcripts from high school and any post-secondary institutions you have attended sent **directly** to Pacific Life Bible College. If you are currently in high school, ask your high school office to send an interim grade report. Upon completion, an official transcript must be requested. Grade 12 or equivalent (G.E.D.) is required for anyone to earn a degree with PLBC.

### Confidential Personal References

- Confidential Personal Reference:** Fill out the name/address portion of the form and give it to a mature Christian (not a family member or boyfriend/girlfriend/spouse).
- Pastor's Reference:** Fill out the name/address portion of the form and give it to your Pastor/Elder/Youth Sponsor (not a family member).
- Ask your referrer to mail the completed forms **directly** to PLBC. We recommend that you supply stamped, addressed envelopes for each reference.

### TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)

- Students for whom English is a foreign language must submit results of the TOEFL test, as administered worldwide by the Educational Testing Service. PLBC requires a minimum TOEFL score of 550 (paper-based), 213 (computer-based), and 80 (internet-based). PLBC's TOEFL registration number is #9016.

## 2. Accelerated Programs - Bachelor of Theology

Contact the Distance Education Department to inquire about the application requirements for these programs.

- Leader's Track - Advanced leadership development for mature students with extensive ministry experience.
- Degree Upgrade - Integrated undergraduate degree with a concentration of biblical studies and specific ministry interests.

## 3. Institute of Music Ministry Students

- Contact PLBC to set up a musical assessment appointment. Assessments will be held Monday - Thursday the week before the fall semester officially begins. The assessment will help the PLBC music faculty design and organize events and opportunities as well as advise students regarding course selection.

## 4. Professional Counselling Students - Applications Due Before August of the Enrolling Year

- Criminal Record Check that includes **Vulnerable Sector Check** (Go to your local police station and request that a criminal record check be sent to: Pacific Life Bible College, c/o Ivone Juell, 15030 - 66A Ave., Surrey, BC V3S 2A5. Must be from within the last year)
- Students must have completed Grade 12 or equivalency, or be of mature student status.
- Students recently graduated from High School will have to complete 2 years of undergraduate studies.
- Students must have completed an accredited college-level English course or do one of the following: 1) Register and complete PLBC's Distance Education (Correspondence) English course; or 2) Challenge PLBC's English course by successfully passing the exam.
- Students must also submit a completed "Counselling Career Aptitude Assessment Form"
- Enclose two passport size photographs

*Please Note: All documents submitted for admission or transfer credit evaluation become the property of Pacific Life Bible College and will not be returned to or photocopied for the applicant. Documents that can not be replaced should not be submitted, rather, certified copies should be sent.*

# Community Responsibilities

We would like to welcome you to community living at Pacific Life Bible College! Our mission is:

*"To glorify God and fulfill His Great Commission by helping the church prepare men and women for Spirit-empowered, servant leadership within their churches, families, communities and chosen careers."*

The success of our mission involves a joint commitment by all who are connected with Pacific Life Bible College to be characterized as a joyful, Biblical community. Ministry can only flow out of a life that is truly submitted to God in all areas. Although the Bible is not explicit on every lifestyle issue, a few directives are given that, if applied, create a healthy community where respect and love can grow. The Biblical injunction to love your neighbour as yourself" is the foundation for the following values:

1. Value is given to self-control over self-indulgence
2. Value is given for respect for one's body
3. Value is given for respect for one another and their property
4. Value is given to community interests over self-interest
5. Value is given when personal freedom is set aside:  
for the sake of a brother or sister's spiritual growth  
when it's exercise might be misunderstood to give the appearance of wrong  
when an action endangers another in any way
6. Respect within relationships is demonstrated by showing compassion, practicing unselfishness, and being patient with others' weaknesses.

A community of believers is to be characterized by love for one another. "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourself . . . Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ." Philippians 2:3,5

## **Specific Commitments:**

These are intended to communicate in concrete form the means by which the community seeks to live out the commitment to the mission of Pacific Life Bible College. Although not all expectations are commanded by Scripture, nor offered as a definition of what is right and wrong, they are shared by the whole to build integrity in the community. Because the Community Responsibilities are intended to reflect a preferred lifestyle for those who belong to this community rather than "campus rules," they apply to both on and off campus.

*Commitment to take responsibility for personal spiritual growth.*

Each member of the body of Christ assumes responsibility to pursue personal and corporate spiritual disciplines, to resist temptation and to seek to live in the beauty of personal holiness. It is expected that each student participate in the life of a local church once per week, and that full time

students attend peer mentoring and chapel each once per week. All students are encouraged and fulltime students are required to develop upward and peer mentoring relationships on an ongoing basis.

*Commitment to facilitate a spiritually healthy environment.*

Pacific Life Bible College is a place of personal growth and preparation for servant leadership in all avenues of life. Members of the community nurture growth through commitments to "speak the truth in love", to accept one another, to honestly confront sin for the purpose of restoration, to uphold one another in personal and corporate prayer, and to worship together.

*Commitment to abstain from practices not sanctioned by Scripture.*

It is essential that students exemplify a God-controlled life both on and off the campus by refraining from practices that are biblically condemned. Examples of these behaviors include drunkenness, gossip, occult practices, pornographic involvement, homosexual behaviour and any form of intimate pre-marital or extra marital sexual involvement [Galatians 5]. Students are to avoid these practices and are not to advocate, endorse or imply acceptance of these behaviours. In addition, such attitudes as greed, jealousy, envy lust, bitterness, unrestrained anger and an unforgiving or condemning spirit are not acceptable.

*Commitment to pursue freedom from enslaving habits and to avoid harmful entertainment.*

PLBC recognizes that, while the student prepares for positions of spiritual leadership, he or she will often be viewed as a Christian leader by others. Therefore, commitment to discipleship includes a willingness to be released from bondage and addictions. It is expected that PLBC students refrain from use of alcohol, illegal nonprescription drugs, tobacco or other harmful substances. Members of the community are expected to practice discretion in interpersonal relationships, the choice of television programs, music, movies, computer games, videos, theater and printed matter and to refrain from attending bars and lounges. PLBC recognizes that together as we exercise responsibility by the grace of God the result will be the development of Christlike character (2 Peter 1:5-8) that will form a basis for effective Christian living and ministry.

PLBC recognizes that Scripture does not include specific teaching for every social practice or situation, but does provide guidelines for community life in controversial matters [cf. Romans 14].

*Commitment to accept reproof and correction when needed.*

Those who make a commitment to hear the honest feedback provided through the community are those who continue to grow in the likeness of Christ. When difficulties arise, restoration and discipline are implemented for the purpose of building up one another.

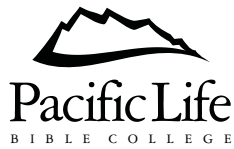

# Statement of Faith

We know we cannot limit God to mere articles of faith, but we recognize the importance of doctrine. The Bible teaches that doctrine must be sound; it must be pure; it must be scriptural; and it must be obeyed. It is important for every believer to have a firm grounding in basic fundamental doctrines found in Scripture. We at Pacific Life Bible College offer the following statements as a summary:

1. **THE HOLY SCRIPTURES:** We believe in the plenary and verbal inspiration of the accepted canon of sacred Scripture as originally given.
2. **THE ETERNAL GODHEAD:** We believe in the Eternal Godhead, Who has revealed Himself as one God, existing in three Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit; distinguishable but indivisible.
3. **THE FALL OF MAN:** We believe in the Creation, Test, and Fall of man, as recorded in Genesis; his total spiritual depravity and inability to attain to divine righteousness.
4. **THE DEITY OF CHRIST:** We believe the only Savior of men is the Lord Jesus Christ. Conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary, He is very God and very man.
5. **THE DEATH AND RESURRECTION OF CHRIST:** We believe that Christ died for our sins, was buried, and rose again the third day; and that He personally appeared to His disciples.
6. **THE ASCENSION AND SECOND COMING OF CHRIST:** We believe in the bodily Ascension of Jesus to Heaven; His exaltation; and His personal, literal and bodily Second Coming for the church.
7. **SALVATION BY GRACE:** We believe in the salvation of sinners by Grace, through repentance and faith in Jesus' perfect and sufficient work on the Cross of Calvary, by which we obtain remission of sins.
8. **WATER BAPTISM:** We believe in the necessity of water baptism by immersion, in the Name of the Eternal Godhead, in order to fulfill the command of Christ.
9. **THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT:** We believe in the baptism of the Holy Spirit as an experience subsequent to salvation, with the scriptural evidence of speaking in other tongues as the Spirit gives utterance.
10. **THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT:** We believe in the operation of the gifts of the Spirit, as manifested in the early Church.
11. **THE SPIRIT-FILLED LIFE:** We believe in a Spirit-filled life of separation from the world and perfecting holiness in the fear of God, as an expression of Christian faith.
12. **DIVINE HEALING:** We believe in the healing of the body by divine Power, as practiced by the Early Church.
13. **THE LORD'S SUPPER:** We believe in the Table of the Lord, commonly called Communion or the Lord's Supper, for believers.
14. **A LITERAL HEAVEN AND HELL:** We believe in eternal life for the believer, and eternal punishment of the unbeliever.
15. **THE JUDGEMENT OF SATAN:** We believe in the reality and personality of Satan, and in the eternal judgment of Satan and his angels.
